

Hi Wendy,

I wish to object to the Temporary Event Notice (TEN) application in relation to 31st March 2024 under the Licensing objective d) The prevention of public nuisance, due to the number of historical and ongoing complaints received from members of the public of noise nuisance. This has resulted in the serving of Abatement Notices on various Companies associated with the Bees Knees licensed premise. The level of music being played is at a volume that is in breach of the Abatement Notices served and the finish time for the music is in breach of Planning permission for use of the premise.

Although the TEN application doesn't include regulated entertainment the Notice giver has indicated to the Licensing Manager that this is a mistake on her part and that a DJ has been hired and therefore I cannot be satisfied that excessively loud music won't be played at this event, as previous warnings issued have been ignored.

I am aware that the Police have been called a number of times due to public disorder associated with this venue.
