Every supply of alcohol under the Premises Licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a Personal Licence.

Each individual carrying out a security activity defined by the Security Industry Act 2001 must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

### **ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH OPERATING SCHEDULE**

The premises will operate in accordance with the plan deposited with the Licensing Authority , drawing number BA 123/AM01 Revision A.

A CCTV system shall be installed, maintained and operated at the premises in liaison with and to the satisfaction of Lancashire Constabulary and shall be used to record during all hours that the premises are open to the public.

Recordings shall be stored in a safe environment for a period of time agreed with the Police Licensing Officers and made available to an authorised officer of the licensing authority or the Police.

Persons who appear to be under the age of 18 years shall be required to produce proof of age by way of one of the following:

- A recognised proof of age card accredited under the British Retail Consortiums Proof of Age Standards Scheme (PASS)
- Photo driving licence
- Passport
- Citizen card supported by the Home Office
- Official ID card issued by HM Forces or European Union bearing a photograph and birth of the holder
- Accredited Student Card

The licence holder and/or the designated premises supervisor or a person nominated by them shall be a member of and regularly attend at the meetings of the Pub and Club Watch schemes for the area within which the premises is located.

Persons under the age of 18 years of age will only be admitted entry to or allowed to remain on the premises if accompanied by a person of 18 years of age or older the premises when trading if accompanied by an adult.

Persons under the age of 18 years will not be permitted to play the All Cash Gaming Machines.

Two SIA registered door staff on duty on Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

A fire log book is to be provided and maintained by a nominated member of staff.
